Key Achievements: National Level-

Quick wins and Milestones

- ✓ **Launch of the national CIP for FP**
- ✓ **MOH signs MoU with UHMG for the Alternative Distribution Strategy for next 5 years**
- ✓ **The President assented to the National Population Council (NPC) Bill into law**
- ✓ **The President publically pronounces his support for FP to enhance economic development**
- ✓ **The MCH Cluster approves inclusion of FP indicators into the Output Performance Tool(OPT)**

District Level Achievements

- ✓ Four focus districts of Gulu, Kanungu, Mubende and Mbale allocate funds for FP in their district budgets & mobilise resources from local partners
- ✓ Business Community in Kanungu District contribute funds to FP- annual contribution of US \$30,000 to top up salaries for the health workers providing FP and US\$8,000 to improve health service delivery

- Follow-up of OPM and MOF to adopt FP indicators in OPT
