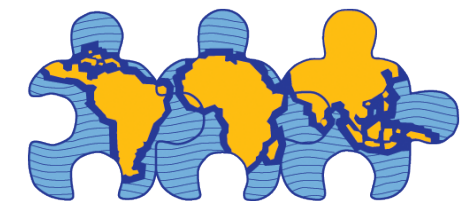

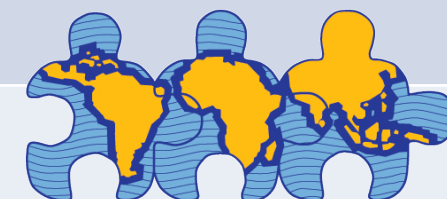

Tracking of FP/RH resources	Tanzania, Uganda
Task shifting/sharing	Uganda
Voices from the South/Champions: Capacity building (including use of tools like Spitfire, RAPID) and deployment (e.g. WD, Addis FP Conference)	EARHN, WARHN, NEAPACOH
District Approach: Prioritizing FP in planning and budgeting processes (2 districts)	Uganda



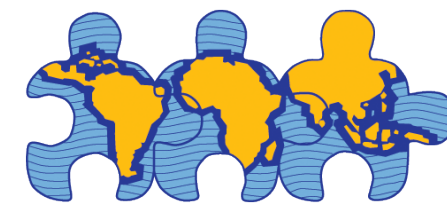

District Approaches beyond prioritizing FP in planning and budgeting processes (FP/RH commodity security, increased access, etc)	Uganda





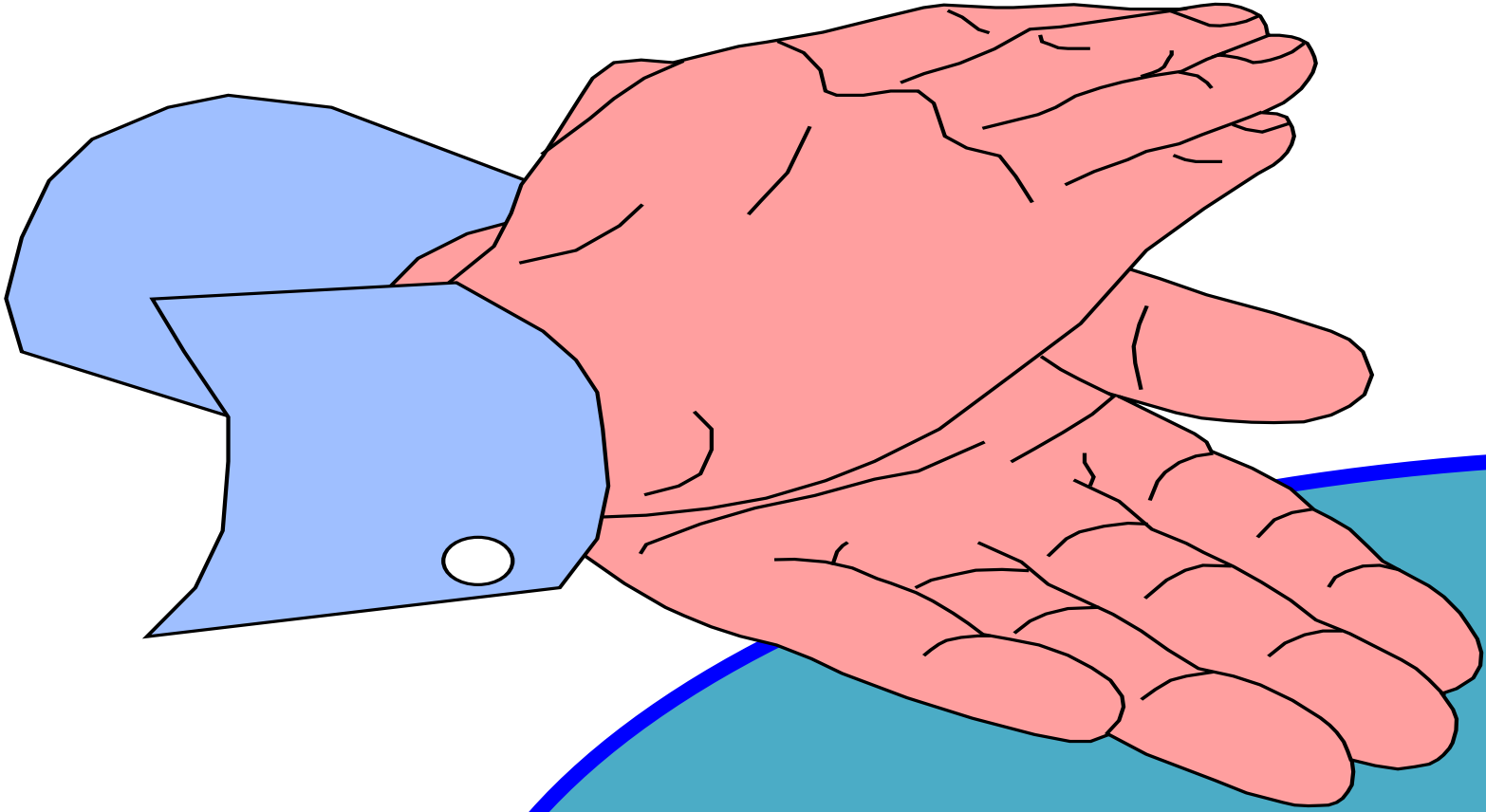
